Clare Society Responsibilities:

- Freshman Retreats take place on *Thursdays* from October - January from 2:45 - 5:15 PM on campus. Each Clare member is required to lead a minimum of 2 retreats from October - January. *Please do not apply for Clare Society if you can not lead at least 2 retreats from Oct-Jan!*
