

Wednesday, March 25 Update:

Dear Saint Anthony's Family,

AS I HAVE MENTIONED TO ALL OF YOU IN EARLIER UPDATES, THE GOVERNOR HAS ORDERED ALL SCHOOLS CLOSED UNTIL APRIL 1. WITH THIS IN MIND, IT IS OUR SINCERE HOPE TO OPEN SCHOOL ON APRIL 2. I AM STILL WAITING TO HEAR FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND THE DIOCESE IF THIS WILL BE EXTENDED.

WHETHER OR NOT WE ARE IN SCHOOL PHYSICALLY OR VIRTUALLY ON APRIL 2, WE WILL MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES TO OUR EASTER BREAK. THERE WILL BE CLASSES ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8 AND WEDNESDAY APRIL 15, THURSDAY, APRIL 16 AND FRIDAY APRIL 17. THERE WILL NOT BE CLASSES ON HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 9, GOOD FRIDAY APRIL 10, EASTER MONDAY, APRIL 13 AND EASTER TUESDAY, APRIL 14.

The Third Quarter ends on March 31. Please understand that if you were not doing well before we went to Virtual Learning, there is still a chance that you may not pass a certain subject. However, you have the Fourth Quarter to improve and turn that around. I know you can do it! Please stay in touch with your Teachers and Guidance counselors. If I can do anything for you, just ask.
