

## UPDATE

Dear Saint Anthony's Family,

**SAINT ANTHONY'S HIGH SCHOOL WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE AS A VIRTUAL SCHOOL UNTIL WEDNESDAY, APRIL 29. IT IS OUR SINCERE HOPE TO OPEN SCHOOL AND RETURN TO LIVE CLASSES ON THURSDAY, APRIL 30.**

Reminder: We are on break from Wednesday April 8 - Friday April 17. Rest, pray, recreate and spend quality time with your families. Please know that we should observe Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter, and Easter Monday as Holy Days. I ask that you use these days for times of prayer and quality family time. You will not be hearing from your teachers during these Holy Days.

## **ACADEMICS**

I strongly suggest that you use the Easter Break to Catch up, Review and Refresh yourself with any work that you are missing. These days are perfect for getting all things in order to make sure you do your best in the Fourth Quarter. Once the break is over, if you are having difficulty with course work, contact your teachers for assistance and help.

### **REGENTS:**

The regents exams are cancelled. The Academic Department Chairpersons have the most recent directives regarding course requirements from the Board of Regents. Based on what I have read, I believe we are in fine shape here at Saint Anthony's.

The information that is most pertinent to our students and parents is the following:

Students who, during the June 2020 examination period would have taken one or more Regents examinations, will be exempted from passing the assessments in order to be issued a diploma. To qualify for the exemption, students must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- The student is currently enrolled in a course of study culminating in a Regents examination and will have earned credit in such course of study by the end of the 2019-20 school year; or
- The student is in grade 7, is enrolled in a course of study culminating in a Regents examination and will have passed such course of study by the end of the 2019-20 school year; or
- The student is currently enrolled in a course of study culminating in a Regents examination and has failed to earn credit by the end of the school year. Such student returns for summer instruction to make up the failed course and earn the course credit and is subsequently granted diploma credit in August 2020; or
- The student was previously enrolled in the course of study leading to an applicable Regents examination, has achieved course credit, and has not yet passed the associated Regents examination but intended to take the test in June 2020 to achieve a passing score.

## **AP EXAMS**

The AP exam schedule will be posted by the AP College Board today. All AP Exams will be taken between May 11 - May 22. No exams are overlapping. More information on AP Testing will be forthcoming. Be sure to regularly check the Library Website for information concerning AP exams.
