NEW: A message from our Athletic Director, Mr. Joseph Minucci:

The Nassau Suffolk Catholic High School Boys and Girls Athletic Associations will move forward with our plan to sponsor Girls Soccer, Boys Soccer, Girls Cross Country, Boys Cross Country, Girls Tennis, and Girls Swimming with a start date of September 21, 2020. Competitions will begin on or after October 9, 2020.

High-risk fall sports, Football, Girls Volleyball, and Competitive Cheer have been postponed until March 1, 2021.

FINAL THOUGHTS:
