Dear Faculty, Parents, and Students,

Today we learned that a staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Our COVID Response Coordinator reported the positive test to the Suffolk and Nassau County Board of Health, and we are following the guidelines being provided to us.

The Health Department will conduct the necessary contact tracing protocols with the cooperation of the infected staff member. ([Contact Tracing Protocol](#)) Those who are contacted by the Health Department will be given further instructions.

Saint Anthony's will close the physical campus tomorrow, Friday September, 18, and conduct Campus III for the entire student body. All teachers and students will participate in remote learning adhering to the following protocols:

- 1) Students will follow their Day 5 schedule and join each class on time via the class' posted Zoom link on Google Classroom. [Bell Schedule](#)
- 2) Any students with connectivity issues, should revert to their teachers' pre-recorded lessons and content posted on the Google Classroom.
- 3) Students will be responsible for any assignments scheduled for tomorrow. If parents need to report any student absences, they can email attendance@stanthonyshs.org

The Saint Anthony's Maintenance Staff will conduct a thorough cleaning of all the school facilities. We will continue to monitor the situation, and provide you with updates as they become available.

The entire student body, faculty and staff should remain vigilant with masks, social-distancing, and hand washing, and contact your health care provider if any COVID-19 symptoms arise. We expect to re-open school on Monday, September 21.
