- **College Board Drops SAT Subject Tests, Optional Essay** [The Washington Post](#) (1/19, Anderson) reports the College Board announced Tuesday that it would discontinue "the optional essay-writing section of the SAT and the supplementary exams in various fields known as SAT subject tests." The organization, citing the coronavirus crisis, said the pandemic has "accelerated a process already underway at the College Board to reduce and simplify demands on students." College Board also "revealed the launch of a process to revise the main SAT, aiming to make the admission test 'more flexible' and 'streamlined' and enable students to take the exam digitally instead of with pencil and paper."
