9th Grade



- Start planning now! Take the right courses and earn the best grades possible.
- Find your high school's list of NCAA approved core courses at <u>eligibilitycenter.org/courselist</u>.

11th Grade



- Check with your counselor to make sure you are on track to complete the required number of NCAA approved courses and graduate on time.
- Take the SAT/ACT and submit scores to the NCAA using code 9999. More information regarding the impact of COVID-19 and test scores can be found on the Eligibility Center website.
- At the end of the year, St. Anthony's will upload official transcripts for all Eligibility Center registered students.

*If you transferred to St. Anthony's, please contact your prior school to submit that transcript to the NCAA.

10th Grade



- Register for an account with the NCAA Eligibility Center at <u>eligibilitycenter.org</u>.
- Monitor your Eligibility Center account for next steps.

12th Grade



- Complete your final NCAA approved core courses as you prepare for graduation.
- Take the SAT/ACT again if necessary and submit to the NCAA using code 9999.
- Request final amateurism certification on your Eligibility Center account.

*Only students on an NCAA DI or DII school's institutional request list will receive a certification.

 After graduation and final transcripts are complete, St. Anthony's will upload to your Eligibility Center account.
