

NSCHSAA SPECTATOR PROTOCOLS

Saint Anthony's High School and all NSCHSAA member schools are working hard to provide a safe environment for all of our student-athletes and fans. Thank you for your cooperation throughout the Spring Sports season.

All spectators are required to wear face coverings while on school grounds and remain socially distanced.

Saint Anthony's High School

All home outdoor sports are limited to 2 spectators per athlete for the home and away teams.

All home indoor sports are limited to 2 spectators per athlete for **Saint Anthony's athletes only**.

There are no spectators for **AWAY** indoor sports.

Saint Anthony's spectators must have a ticket or a bracelet issued by Saint Anthony's to attend home and away contests. No ticket or bracelet, no entry.

Spectators for contests held in the **GYMNASIUM** should check-in at the main entrance. Security will log your name and take your temperature.

Spectators for contests held on **CY DONNELLY FIELD** are required to enter at the path at the northwest corner of the main parking lot. Spectators must remain in the bleachers for the duration of the contest.

Spectators for contests held on the **FRONT FIELD** are required to check-in by the bleachers. Spectators may remain in the bleachers for the duration of the contest.

Home and away spectators for **SOFTBALL** games must enter at the path at the northwest corner of the main parking lot. Home spectators may use the bleachers near the third-base dugout and the grass area in left field foul territory. Away fans must sit in the grass area behind the right-field fence; please bring chairs.

Home and away spectators for **BASEBALL** games at Saint Anthony's are required to enter at the road between the student center and athletic fields. Home fans may use the bleachers located behind home plate. Away fans may use the road between the student center and baseball field.

Home and away spectators for **BASEBALL and TENNIS** games/matches at Terry Farrell or other off-site Saint Anthony's athletic events must follow the 2 spectators per athlete policy or the home schools spectator policy.

SPECTATORS AT CHAMINADE

All spectators are required to wear face coverings while on school grounds and remain socially distanced.

2 spectators per athlete for outdoor sports. NO spectators for indoor sports.

SPECTATORS AT HOLY TRINITY

The school building is closed to all visitors. Rest Rooms are located behind the main field bleachers.

2 spectators per athlete for outdoor sports. NO spectators for indoor sports.

Boys and Girls Lacrosse, Track and Field – Enter through the gate behind the bleachers on New Bridge Road.

Baseball - Enter through single gate to the right of the baseball backstop. Please bring your chairs and socially distance as much as possible
(Please do not park in the Parking Lot next to the baseball backstop)

Softball – (Cantiague Park) – Please adhere to the 2 spectator rule, and follow any/all guidelines set forth by the Park.

SPECTATORS AT KELLENBERG

2 spectators per athlete for outdoor sports. NO spectators for indoor sports..

Lacrosse: Entry point at our bleachers for access.

Softball: Entry point at the gate to the softball field. Spectators will need to sit behind the home run fence.

SPECTATORS AT OUR LADY OF MERCY

2 spectators per visiting student athlete for lacrosse & softball, not badminton.

SPECTATORS AT SACRED HEART ACADEMY

Lacrosse: SHA will only be able to support HOME athlete spectators for lacrosse this year.

Softball: SHA will be able to support 2 spectators of home and away athletes this year. Gries Park is a public park that requires temperature checks, masks, and social distancing. Supervisors should check spectators' temperatures, identification and help maintain social distancing and mask-wearing. Spectators may want to bring a chair.

SPECTATORS AT ST. DOMINIC

2 spectators per athlete for outdoor sports. NO spectators for indoor sports..

All Outdoor Sports: Please check-in at the gate upon entering.

SPECTATORS AT ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST

2 spectators per athlete for outdoor sports. NO spectators for indoor sports..

Lacrosse: Enter the walkway from the parking lot and be checked in there-then proceed to the bleachers on the north side of the field

Softball: Please stay on the outside of the fence along the 3rd base side, hugging the parking lot
