UNIFORM CODE 2021-2022

BOYS (11th Grade)

- · Gray uniform slacks worn at waist level
- Black uniform blazer with embroidered school emblem (Oct. 19 - May 18)
- Black sleeveless sweater vest with the embroidered school emblem
- White oxford uniform button-down shirt either long or short sleeve tucked into the slacks completely with shirt cuffs, neck and collar buttoned. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt.
- · Uniform black and gold patterned tie
- · Black socks only
- · Uniform Black Leather Belt
- White Cross black uniform shoes only. Shoes are not to be "clogged" (back heel bent down).

The School Sleeveless Sweater Vest must be worn by all Juniors for the Junior Orientation Day, September 8, 2021 as well as the following dates:

September 29, 2021 through June 3, 2022

Grooming Standards

Hair must be neatly groomed, and cut to fall above the ear and shirt collar. Extreme, trendy or faddish hairstyles, two toned hair color, and unnatural colors, i.e. green, purple, bright red or bleached, etc., are not permitted.

Some examples of unacceptable hairstyles would be partially or completely shaven hair and/or long hair styles, designs, hairstyles involving significant contrast in length.

Boys are to be clean shaven, with no facial hair, no side-

burns, earrings, body piercings or tatoos.

GIRLS (11th Grade)

- Gray box pleated uniform skirt (worn to cover the knee)
- Black uniform blazer with the embroidered school emblem (Oct. 19 May 18)
- · Black sleeveless sweater vest with the embroidered school emblem
- White oxford button-down uniform shirt either long or short sleeve tucked into skirt completely with cuffs and collar buttoned, and if desired, the top button only left open. Sleeves must be buttoned and uncuffed. The hemmed, three-quarter length sleeved shirt is optional for Juniors. When worn underneath the uniform vest, it must not be visible outside the vest. Any new blouse orders will be the three-quarter hemmed blouse only.
- Black tights are worn once the school sleeveless sweater vest are required (Sept. 29), and are removed once sweater vests are no longer required (June 3). Leggings or footless tights are not permitted as a substitute for tights and skin/ankle must not be visible at any time. Any student who wears ripped stockings or leggings to school in place of tights must purchase a pair of black tights in theGeneral Office. Solid black ankle socks (not visible outside the shoe) only may be worn.
- White Cross black uniform shoes only. The back heel of the shoe may not be bent down or shoes are not to be "clogged" (back heel bent down).

The School Sleeveless Sweater Vest must be worn by all Juniors for the Junior Orientation Day, September 8, 2021 as well as the following dates:

September 29, 2021 through June 3, 2022

Grooming Standards

Girls hairstyles, make-up and jewelry must be appropriate to the school setting and in keeping with the uniform dress code.

Earrings may be worn only on the earlobes and no other body piercings are permitted. Extreme, trendy or faddish hairstyles, included shaved or buzzed cuts, two toned hair color, and those involving unnatural colors, i.e. purple, green, bright red, or bleached, etc., are not permitted. No tattoos are permitted.

*All Uniform and Grooming regulations are required for the beginning of school, September 7 - 10.

- 1. Uniform Blazers must be worn from October 19 through May 18. During this time, the Uniform Blazer must be worn throughout the entire school day.
- Students are to arrive and remain in uniform throughout the entire school day (7:55 A.M. 2:50 P.M.)
 Students changing into Gym clothing for Physical Education class must do so in the Locker Rooms.
 They are not to appear in Gym clothes or sneakers at any time other than Physical Education classes.
- Colored or decorative T-shirts or tank tops are not permitted under the Uniform blouse/shirt. No baseball caps, hats, or head coverings
 may be worn in school throughout the school day.
- 4. Electronic Equipment: If used or displayed during school hours (7:55 A.M. 2:50 P.M.) will be confiscated and the Student will receive detention. All Electronic Devices (cell phones, ipods, etc.) must be kept in the "Off" position during school hours.

October 13th, 2021 PSAT

Dear 10th and 11th Grade Students & Parents:

Saint Anthony's High School will administer an optional Preliminary Standardized Achievement Test (PSAT) to Sophomores and Juniors ONLY, on Wednesday October 13, 2021.

Any families wishing to sign up for this exam can register at: https://www.stanthonyshs.org/psat-registration/. The registration fee for the PSAT is \$25. All registrations must be submitted by Friday, August 20, 2021. The PSAT will be administered from 8:20AM-12:15PM. Busing will be available for students taking the PSAT. However, students with extended time must remain for the full duration of their exam and will need to make arrangements to be picked up after the test.

Students with a 504 or IEP who wish to use their accommodations must be pre-approved by the College Board to use them. If you have not been pre-approved for accommodations, the following consent form: (https://accommodations.collegeboard.org/pdf/ssd-consent-form-accommodations.pdf) should be signed and returned to Mrs. Donnelly (cdonnelly@stanthonyshs.org) for students with 504 plan and Dr. Burton (fburton@stanthonyshs.org) for students with an IEP as soon as possible to begin the approval process. The approval process may take as long as 7 weeks. Students with extended time must stay the full time and should make arrangements to be picked up after their exam.

Classes will be cancelled on Wednesday, October 13, to facilitate students taking these exams. Sophomores and Juniors who have yet to take the PSAT are strongly encouraged to register.


