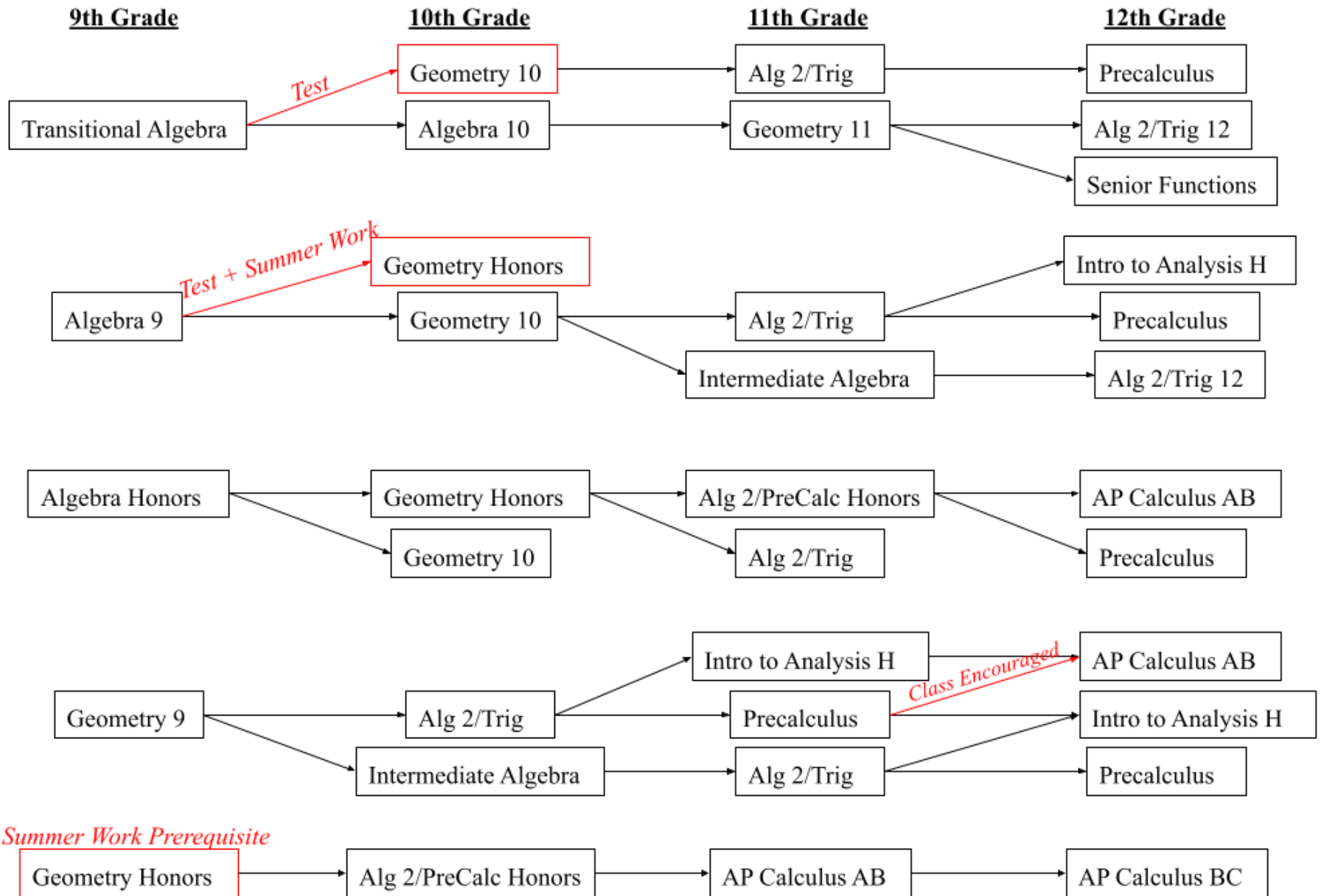


Typical Math Tracks + Optional Movements



* We also offer: AP Statistics, AP Computer Science Principles, AP Computer Science A, Intro to Computer Science Honors, Intro to Engineering, and Advanced Engineering

Tests will be given for the following circumstances:

1. Students trying to advance from Transitional Algebra → Geometry 10.
2. Students trying to advance from Algebra 9 → Geometry Honors. [Summer work is also required.]
3. Students trying to advance from Geometry 10 → Alg2/PreCalc Honors. [Summer work is also required.]
4. Students trying to advance from Alg2/Trig → AP Calculus AB. [Summer class is also required.]
5. Students trying to advance from Precalculus → AP Calculus AB. [No test is required. Students must have a 92% or above average in Precalculus to advance. It is highly encouraged that students do the summer class.]
6. Students wanting to advance from Alg2/Trig → AP Statistics. [No test is required. Students must have a 95% or above average in Alg2/Trig and receive approval from the Math Department Chair.]

In order to qualify for a jump (any movement above the regular progression), the following is required:

- 92% or above average in current Math class
- Teacher Recommendation
- Completion of the Qualifying Exam

The final decision as to what course the student is approved for will be emailed to them by the Math Department Chair.
