AP Exam Information

 It is a requirement for all students enrolled in an AP Class to take the AP Exam. To register for the exam you must complete <u>TWO STEPS</u>. These steps can be done in any order and can be done at separate times. <u>Note: NOV. 1, 2023</u> IS THE DEADLINE DATE TO AVOID A \$45 PENALTY FEE imposed by the College Board. - 1. Click here to make a payment for the Exam(s)
- 2. Students must join the AP Resource Classroom (**DIFFERENT FROM GOOGLE CLASSROOM**) for each AP Class they are enrolled in. Join Codes are provided by their Classroom Teacher the first week of school.
- Students who wish to take an AP Exam for a class not in their schedule, should make a
 payment first and receive a JOIN CODE from Mrs. Adler in the Library PRIOR to Nov. 1 to avoid
 a \$45 penalty.
