

St. Anthony's High School Financial Aid FAQ

1) When can I apply for financial aid?

First, you must register your son/daughter with admissions. More information is available at www.stanthonyshs.org/tuition.

The process begins February 1, and the application closes on August 1, 2024.

2) How do you determine the amount of Financial Aid I may qualify for?

Blackbaud, a third party software company, processes all the information you provide and makes a recommendation to Saint Anthony's based on that information. Visit www.stanthonyshs.org/tuition for details.

3) What is the average Financial Aid amount?

It is impossible to give an average amount as applications are dealt with on a case by case basis. Not all applicants receive financial aid while a typical award is equal to approximately 10% of the tuition for those that do qualify. Financial Aid awards are strictly NEED-based.

4) What information do I need to provide to apply for Financial Aid?

There is a variety of information that you will need to provide when you fill out the online application. Your most recent tax returns must be available.

5) Where do I send all the information requested in the Financial Aid Packet?

The website includes instructions for navigating the application and submitting all necessary information electronically.

6) How much time will it take to process my application?

The Financial Aid Committee meets in June and July, and you will be notified electronically around that time after your application is assessed.

7) Can I apply for Financial Aid before I pay the registration fee?

The registration fee must be paid and all enrollment steps completed before you are eligible to apply for Financial Aid. Financial aid is only awarded to families committed to sending their student to St. Anthony's High School.

8) Are there any other scholarships or other sources of aid available aside from Financial Aid?

Entrance Exam Scholarships are the only other awards offered by St. Anthony's H.S. These are determined by the student's performance on the TACHS exam (Catholic High School entrance).

9) Do I have to reapply for Financial Aid each academic year?

Every academic year that your child is at Saint Anthony's, you have to reapply for Financial Aid to be considered for an award. However, you are only eligible for Financial Aid if your tuition balance is current. Students with outstanding tuition balances are denied Financial Aid.
