Goal Two: Get Involved in Your Classes, Clubs and Athletics

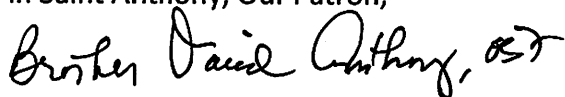
Goal Three: Get to Know ME! Greet Me! Visit Me! My office is always Open for you to visit!

You will be praying in school each day throughout the school year. I leave you with a small part of the School Prayer to Saint Anthony:

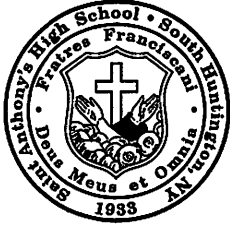

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St. Anthony's Implementation of a "Phone-Free" School Day

August 2026

Dear Students and Parents,

I hope you are enjoying a restful summer. As you are aware, the Governor and the NY State Legislature approved legislation prohibiting the use of smartphones and internet-enabled devices in all schools across New York State.

Although as a private Catholic school, St. Anthony's is not bound to this legislation, we do agree that the pervasive use of smartphones poses both a health hazard and an educational detriment to our students. St. Anthony's continues to implement a "Phone-Free" school day.

We encourage students and parents to read the details below, so that our expectations are clear.

Policy Overview:

Students are required to store their personal mobile devices in their designated lockers no later than 8:20AM (or upon their initial arrival to school), and may retrieve them after the 2:30 PM dismissal bell.

This policy is designed to encourage direct interpersonal engagement, minimize distractions, and promote a more contemplative and compassionate school environment.

Disciplinary Consequences for Cell Phone Use:

Any student found using their cell phone or accessing their locker during instructional hours (8:20 AM – 2:30 PM), unless approved for a late arrival or early dismissal, will face the following disciplinary consequences:

First Infraction

- The phone is confiscated and delivered to Brother David's Office. The **student** can retrieve the phone at the end of the school day.
- After-school detention
- -10 Character Points
- The student's parent will be contacted, and the incident will be recorded in the student's disciplinary file.

Second Infraction

- The phone is confiscated and delivered to Brother David's Office. The **student's parent** must come to the school to retrieve the student's phone.
- Double Detention
- -15 Character Points
- Incident recorded in the student's disciplinary file

Third Infraction

- The phone is confiscated and delivered to Brother David's Office. The **student's parent** must come to the school to retrieve the student's phone.
- In-School Suspension
- Behavioral Probation
- -20 Character Points
- Mandatory meeting with the student's Guidance Counselor
 - During this meeting, the **parent/guardian will be contacted.**
 - Student and parent must sign an **affidavit acknowledging that a fourth infraction will result in a formal meeting with Administration.**

Fourth Infraction

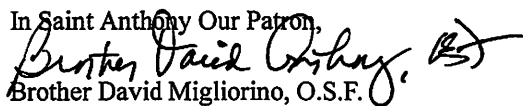
- Dismissal from St. Anthony's

****Locker use between the times of 8:20 AM and 2:30 PM is strictly prohibited... Students caught using lockers during school hours will receive detention.****

****Ear buds, Air pods, Smartwatches, and all other wearable and/or personal computing devices are all strictly prohibited from 8:20AM to 2:30PM. Any student who uses these listening devices during the school day will receive detention.****

UNIFORM CODE 2026-2027

BOYS (9th Grade)

- Black uniform slacks worn at waist level
- Gray uniform blazer with embroidered school emblem (Oct. 13 - May 26)
- Gray sleeveless sweater vest with the embroidered school emblem
- White oxford uniform button-down shirt either long or short sleeve tucked into the slacks completely with shirt cuffs, neck and collar buttoned. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt.
- Uniform black and gold patterned tie
- Black socks only
- Uniform Black Leather Belt
- White Cross black uniform shoes only. Shoes are not to be "clogged" (back heel bent down).

The School Sleeveless Sweater Vest must be worn by all Freshmen for the Freshman Orientation Day, September 11, 2026 as well as the following dates:

September 30, 2026 through the last day of classes, June 9, 2027.

Grooming Standards

Hair must be neatly groomed, and cut to fall above the ear, eyes and shirt collar. Extreme, trendy or faddish hairstyles, two toned hair color, and unnatural colors, i.e. green, purple, bright red or bleached, etc., are not permitted.

Some examples of unacceptable hairstyles would be partially or completely shaven hair and/or long hair styles, designs, hairstyles involving significant contrast in length.

Boys are to be clean shaven, with no facial hair, no side-burns, earrings, body piercings or visible tattoos.

GIRLS (9th Grade)

- Black knife pleated uniform skirt (worn to cover the knee)
- Gray uniform blazer with the embroidered school emblem (Oct. 13 - May 26)
- Black sleeveless sweater vest with the embroidered school emblem
- The hemmed, three-quarter length sleeved shirt is required. When worn underneath the uniform vest, it must not be visible outside the vest. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt.
- Black, footed tights are worn from Orientation Day until the last day of classes (June 9) Leggings or footless tights are not permitted as a substitute for tights and skin/ankle must not be visible at any time. Any student who wears ripped stockings or leggings to school in place of tights must purchase a pair of black tights in the General Office. Solid black ankle socks (not visible outside the shoe) only may be worn.
- White Cross black uniform shoes only. The back heel of the shoe may not be bent down or shoes are not to be "clogged" (back heel bent down).

The School Sleeveless Sweater Vest must be worn by all Freshmen for the Freshman Orientation Day, September 11, 2026 as well as the following dates:

September 30, 2026 through the last day of classes, June 9, 2027.

Grooming Standards

Girls hairstyles, make-up and jewelry must be appropriate to the school setting and in keeping with the uniform dress code. Earrings may be worn only on the earlobes and no other body piercings are permitted. Extreme, trendy or faddish hairstyles, including shaved or buzzed cuts, two toned hair color, and those involving unnatural colors, i.e. purple, green, bright red, or bleached, etc., are not permitted. No visible tattoos are permitted.

*All Uniform and Grooming regulations are required for the beginning of school, September 8 – 11.

1. Uniform Blazers must be worn from October 13 through May 26. During this time, the Uniform Blazer must be worn throughout the entire school day.
2. Students are to arrive and remain in uniform throughout the entire school day (7:45 AM - 2:50 PM) Students changing into Gym clothing (SAHS T-shirt and black shorts) for Physical Education class must do so in the Locker Rooms. They are not to appear in Gym clothes or sneakers at any time other than Physical Education classes.
3. Colored or decorative T-shirts or tank tops are not permitted under the Uniform blouse/shirt. No baseball caps, hats, or head coverings may be worn in school throughout the school day.

Fall Sports Clearance Information 2026

Fall Sports Clearance begins on **Friday, July 24, 2026, and concludes on Friday, August 14, 2026.**

Beginning July 24, all parents and student-athletes must log in to FinalForms to review, complete, and electronically sign all required forms for the upcoming school year.

FinalForms saves your information from season to season and year to year. Please take a few minutes to carefully review all information, make any necessary updates, and complete all required signatures.

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Important: We encourage you to upload your most recent physical examination prior to July 24. **However**, all required forms must be reviewed, updated, and signed between July 24 and August 14.

IF ALL FORMS ARE NOT COMPLETED BY AUGUST 14th, YOU MAY NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND TRYOUTS.

Saint Anthony's nurses will begin approving or declining medical documents during the time frame above. Please do not visit the school nurse at Saint Anthony's. The nurse will **only approve physicals uploaded to FinalForms.**

ST. ANTHONY'S HIGH SCHOOL

Partnering for Teen Success

1. ATTENDANCE & THE 24-HOUR RULE

Consistent attendance is vital for academic excellence. Students must be present every day unless truly ill.

STAY HOME (Red Light): Fever of **100.4°F** or higher, or active vomiting (not due to anxiety). Must be symptom-free for 24 hours without medication before returning.

ATTEND SCHOOL (Green Light): Mild sniffles or headaches without fever. These are often anxiety-based; staying home increases stress and workload, making catching up more difficult.

Accountability: If home sick, students must check Google Classroom and email teachers regarding missed work.

2. MANNERS, RESPECT & THE UNITED FRONT

- **Manners:** Encourage eye contact and polite language ("Please," "Thank you") with all staff and peers.
- **The United Front:** Always support the teacher and school policy in front of your teen. Contact the school privately for clarification. A united front prevents teens from shifting blame to avoid accountability.

3. DIGITAL RESPONSIBILITY & CELL PHONE POLICY

- **Follow the Handbook:** Familiarize yourself and your teen with the Student Handbook rules. Cell phones and electronic devices must follow school regulations strictly during hours of instruction.
- **The Footprint:** Everything online is permanent. If you wouldn't want an administrator or future employer to see it, do not post it.
- **Home Focus:** Keep phones in a separate room during homework and out of bedrooms overnight for restful sleep.

4. RESPONSIBILITY & ACCOUNTABILITY

- **Natural Consequences:** Allow your teen to experience the outcome of missed deadlines, unexcused tardiness, or handbook infractions. Growth happens through learning from mistakes.
- **Ownership:** Teens should track their own grades and behavioral responsibilities. Transition from asking "Did you do it?" to "What is your plan for your responsibilities this week?"

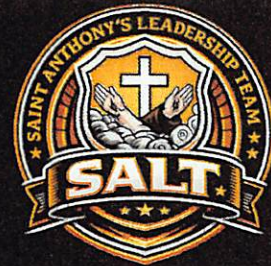

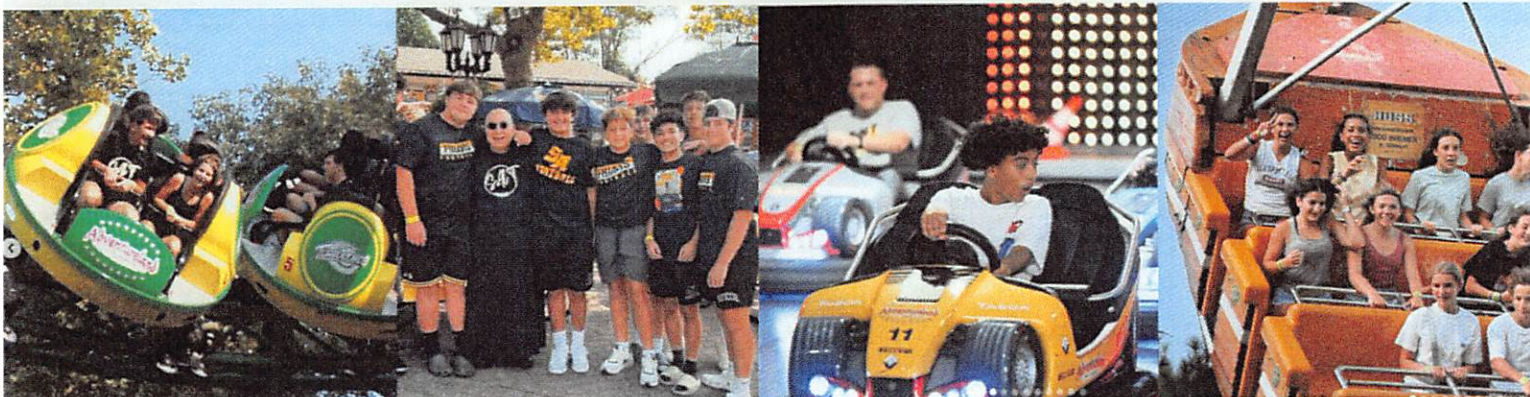

The safety of your children is our utmost priority, and we want to ensure a smooth and secure process for dropping off and picking up your child at the end of the day. Please take a moment to review the following guidelines.

- Drop off is at 3:00pm. **No Entrance** after 3:30pm
- Students must remain until 6:00 PM. No exit before 5:30 PM.
- You must drop your child off at the rear Main Gate located within the Adventureland Parking Lot. **NOT ON ROUTE 110.**

Pickup Information:

- Please be on time for the 6:00pm pickup.
- Please stay in touch with your child to let them know you have arrived.
- We have a designated PICK-UP area by the main entrance of Adventureland, where you dropped off your child.
- Once you have arrived, you **MUST** exit your vehicle and will be greeted by your child with a member of our faculty.
- Any and all rideshare options (Uber, Lyft, Taxi, etc.): **are strictly prohibited.**
- **No student is allowed to leave the park without a St. Anthony's faculty member seeing/greeting their parent.**

Dress Code: Neat casual attire: no ripped jeans, no spandex, no tank tops, no leggings, no short shorts or beach attire, no mini-skirts, or any indecent or revealing clothing. Modesty from "Neck to Knees".
